QUICK GUIDE TO GERMINATING & PLANTING

Wrap seed in paper dampened towel.

Place in a plastic bag or container.

Place this in a warm spot for 3 – 5 days.

The humidity must be high, cover with lid to trap humidity.

If you have a heated fish tank or esky with fish tank heater float these seeds in the bag or container on top of water. Have water level as high as possible to save air going stale.

Fish tanks are a great germinator.

When the seeds germinate plant out into pots.

Pots can be made from newspaper rolled around a wine bottle or large paper drink cups. Paper will rot in ground after transplanting.

Transfer to garden when there is about 4 leaves. (Slice paper to allow roots to grow out of pot).



Seeds wrapped in damp paper toweling floating on top of heated water.



Place sprouted seed root down into pot with good potting mix at about this stage of germination.

Be very careful not to damage root.
